



Bee Haven Added Policies During Covid-19 Pandemic

- There will be additional daily cleaning done in rooms occupied by children
- Bee Haven staff will support social distancing in all the programs: by placing chairs apart from each other, and reminding children to be apart from one another
- No activities using school buses, or public transportation will take place
- Activities will take place outdoors as much as possible
- In accordance with local and provincial regulations Bee Haven will use playgrounds under the following provisions: 1. Children are maintaining a two metre physical distance when playing, and 2. Bee Haven will bring hand sanitizer for use directly before and after playing on the playground. Hand washing will take place directly upon returning to Bee Haven's site.
- Children will be prompted to wash their hands frequently by staff, and staff will supervise as they do so
- Children exhibiting cold or flu symptoms will be asked to stay home, and not attend Bee Haven
- Children who have returned to Canada since March 1st , 2020 will be asked to stay home for a minimum of 14 days
- Parents/caregivers are asked to notify Bee Haven staff immediately if their children are exhibiting symptoms, or have recently been out of the country
